



AMBASSADOR AMI MPUNGWE – BIOGRAPHY

Ambassador Ami Ramadhan Mpungwe brings to Tanzania Breweries Plc (TBL) a distinguished career spanning more than 25 years in Tanzania's Diplomatic Service and over two decades of leadership in the private sector.

He graduated from the University of Dar es Salaam in 1975 with a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in Political Science and International Relations and subsequently joined Tanzania's Foreign Service as a career diplomat. Over the course of his diplomatic career, he held several senior positions, including Personal Assistant to the President of the United Republic of Tanzania, Private Secretary to the Chief Secretary and Secretary to the Cabinet, and Director of Africa and Middle East Affairs in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

In 1994, Ambassador Mpungwe was appointed Tanzania's first High Commissioner to South Africa, with concurrent accreditation to Botswana, Lesotho, and Namibia. In recognition of his outstanding contribution to strengthening diplomatic relations, he was awarded South Africa's prestigious Order of Good Hope. He retired from the Diplomatic Service in December 1999 and transitioned into the private sector.

Since then, Ambassador Mpungwe has established an exceptional track record in corporate governance and business leadership. He has chaired the boards of several leading organizations, including MultiChoice Tanzania, Millicom Tanzania Ltd.(Tigo) , Kilombero Sugar Company, and the Tanzania Chamber of Minerals and Energy. He has also served as a board member of Standard Chartered Bank Tanzania, National Bank of Commerce (NBC), Zambia Sugar Plc, and other prominent institutions across the region.

A respected statesman and accomplished corporate leader, Ambassador Mpungwe has served on the Tanzania Breweries Plc Board of Directors since 2001, providing strategic guidance and oversight during a significant period of the company's growth and transformation.
